COUNCIL & DENOMINATION NEWS

April 2025 council meeting notes

1. The council is grateful for the many willing servants of all ages who blessed our church family in joyful fellowship and praise at our Easter breakfast and worship service. God is good!
2. A less expensive alternative to the "One Call Now" messaging system is still being researched.
3. An updated version of the council guidebook was approved.
4. Elder/deacon teams met to discuss district matters.
5. Plans were made to accommodate extra guests when two WMC choral groups join us in worship on May 4. (See the sign-up sheet downstairs for how you can help.)
6. The council meets again on May 28.

Giving for the first quarter of 2025 to the general fund was \$84,619, up \$18,369 from our budget. In addition, \$5,058 was donated in memory of Alan Wolffis. Special offerings included:

Allen Ave Cadets \$473

Resonate Global \$161

Muskegon Chrisitan School \$979

While we tend to run higher in the first quarter, with the timing of annual and semi-annual gifts, we are still trending to be slightly favorable to our budget for the year. Thank you, Allen Ave, for your generosity and support as we continue to B.L.E.S.S.

The council has approved the following proposal and is bringing it to the members of the congregation for their **vote after the worship service today.**

"The building committee proposes the purchase of carpeting (with installation) for the church offices, library, east stairways, east entrance, and basement coatroom area. The carpeting would be provided by Carpet Bonanza of Zeeland at a quoted estimated cost of \$22,813. The building committee (with guidance from the finance committee) requests approval of funding not to exceed \$25,000 from the estate fund."

Note that this quote includes removal of the old carpet. If you have any questions, please contact a member of the council or the building committee. You are welcome to view carpet samples in the library.
