

### **COUNCIL & DENOMINATION NEWS**

The council has approved the following proposal and will bring it to the members of the congregation for their vote after the worship service on April 27.

"The building committee proposes the purchase of carpeting (with installation) for the church offices, library, east stairways, east entrance, and basement coatroom area. The carpeting would be provided by Carpet Bonanza of Zeeland at a quoted estimated cost of \$22,813. The building committee (with guidance from the finance committee) requests approval of funding not to exceed \$25,000 from the estate fund."
