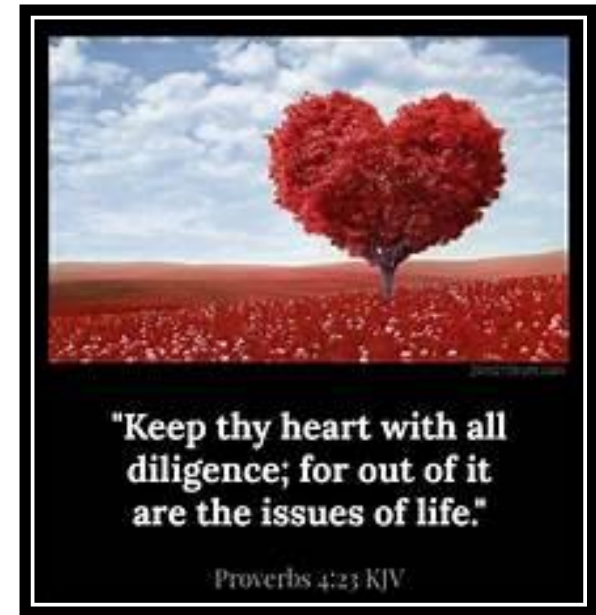

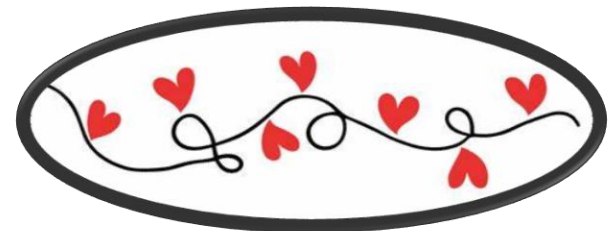

Update from our sister church in New Era CRC RE: their Latino Outreach

Ministry: We're grateful to Classis Muskegon churches for their continued support of our Latino Ministry. Despite disappointment, we've experienced incredible joy this past year. Even though Rev. Villatoro was unable to join our ministry, we nonetheless expanded our outreach to Oceana County through the New Era Farmer's Market, Personal Care Pantry, and Love INC of Oceana County. This year, we hosted two English tutoring students, visited migrant worker housing, and distributed over 200 Spanish Bibles throughout our community. This coming year, we're hosting an ESL tutor training and hope to launch a Bible study. We're also exploring factory chaplaincy at the local canneries and translation tools for worship, even as we continue the search for a Latino pastor with four promising candidates. We appreciate your prayers and support as we strive to be a church for our whole community!

On Sundays after the morning service, from January 18 through February 1, **there will be a three-week "class" on making profession of faith** and joining Allen Avenue as a member of the congregation. Do you want to know more about baptism and making profession of faith? Are you discerning God's call to join the church as a member, with its privileges and responsibilities? Come join us for conversation, led by Pastor Mark and the elders, about how you are a vital part of Allen Avenue's mission to "Live to Bless."
