

COUNCIL & DENOMINATION NEWS

Council Meeting Notes from August 27 -- We reviewed several reports from committees and had a lot of discussion on several topics including:

- Potentially cleaning the carpets in our sanctuary.
- Potentially pursuing air conditioning for our sanctuary.
- Potential use of the parsonage after the Hofman's have completed their move.
- Ongoing security issues. How to be open and inviting, yet provide a safe environment for worship in the challenging world we live in.
 - Discussion on a schedule for Council nominations and a new budget for 2026.

We passed three motions:

- Approved spending \$6,000 for additional cameras and installation, providing a more comprehensive upgrade to our current system. This will give us a more reliable, effective and easily managed security system.
- Approved spending \$1,500 to replace the TV screen in front of the sanctuary, (used by the worship team) with a new large screen TV mounted near the back of the sanctuary.
- Approved increasing our future ministry shares pledge for the Christian Reformed Church in North America. This will be reflected as a 1% increase in the 2026 Budget.
